Making Jesus Christ your All

Bible: Were you faithful in spending time with God in His Word? What did it reveal about God, new life in Christ, and His will for you as a disciple of Jesus?



Multiply: How were you challenged to grow as a disciple-maker through the *Multiply* material?

Worship: When did you spend quiet time with the Lord this week? How did you express love, worship and surrender to Him as Savior and Lord?

Walk: What challenges are you facing to abide in Christ throughout each day? What daily changes do you need to make to walk as a Spirit-filled disciple?

Temptation: What idols of the heart are revealed by your temptation or sin this week? What changes are needed so you will walk with Jesus in victory?

Stewardship: This week, were you a faithful steward of your finances? How did you invest your time and gifting into the growth of His kingdom?

Relationships: Did you invest quality time to intentionally love, serve and lead your family? Did you influence others to make Jesus their all?

Unity: Do you need to extend grace and reconciliation to anyone (no name) who has wronged you, or you have wronged, in word or action?

Prayer: Did you pray for this group, and those God wants us to reach? Did you faithfully pray for the unchurched in your places of influence?

Evangelism: In what ways did you intentionally serve and verbally invite others into a relationship with Jesus Christ and His church this week?
